*BCTA time points are based on normal service delivery and serve as approximate times that we service an area. Riders should note that our buses will not run early, but factors, which are outside of BCTA's control, may cause delays. These factors may include: inclement weather, road construction and detours, vehicular accidents, and heavy ridership during peak days and times.*

- RIDE HALF FARE**
- Persons with Disabilities with a Reduced Fare Transit ID Card (goldenrod or green)
  - All passengers with a red, white, and blue Medicare Card
  - Children aged 6-11 who are riding with a fare-paying adult
  - Children aged 5 and under who are riding with a non-fare paying adult
  - Children aged 5 and under who are riding with a fare-paying adult, but exceed the 2 child limit

**HOLIDAY SERVICE**

The Beaver County Transit Authority does not operate on Sunday or the following holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day (July 4th), Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. BCTA generally operates a Holiday Schedule with reduced service the Friday after Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve.
